Welcome

Hello, my name is Mrs. Corbitt and I am so excited to be your child's second grade teacher! I have been busy preparing for an exciting year and I know that we are going to have a wonderful time. I look forward to working with you to make this school year both meaningful and fun.

School Attendance

Your child's regular and on-time attendance at school is crucial to his/her success. It is also school policy to send in a note explaining your child's absence within 3 days of returning to school. Only then will the absence be "excused."

School Hours: 8:30-3:00 p.m.

Morning Arrival

Second grade students meet their teachers every morning in the second grade (brown) hallway between 8:00-8:25 a.m. Please do not bring your child to school before that time unless he/she is enrolled in morning extended day, as there is no one to supervise your child before 8:00 a.m.

Dismissal

School is dismissed beginning at 2:50 p.m. Car riders will be gathered by grade level in front of the school. You **MUST** have your child's color-coded sign in your car either on your dash or propped up in the glass by your visor. Children that ride the bus or are park 'n ride or walkers will be escorted by a teacher to their proper area to wait for dismissal.

If you need to pick up your child early, you must sign him or her out at the office. The office will call the classroom and ask for your child to be sent down. Please be mindful that there is no early check out early after 2:15 p.m.

***ALL transportation changes must be in writing. If the change is not in writing I will have to send your child home the way that is documented. Thank you for your cooperation.

Supplies

Please make sure to bring in the items requested on the supply list. If you need an extra list please let me know or visit our classroom website. Thank you so much to everyone that has already sent in supplies. I really appreciate it!!!

Family-Teacher Communication

I believe that school is a partnership between school, home, and your child. As a member of this partnership, I will communicate with your family regarding classroom events, your child's progress, etc.

Your child will receive an agenda book on the first day of school. Please look for this important communication tool and check your child's binder every day for newsletters, notes, and home activities. Your child's binder is the best way that I can transport school related information to you! There might be important days and deadlines in your child's binder and I don't want you to miss them. It is important that it is checked and cleaned out daily. ☺

Money

On occasion it will be necessary for your child to bring money to school. Please always send money in a sealed envelope or ziplock bag with the following information written on it:

1. Your child's first and last name
2. The amount of money
3. The purpose for the money
4. My name and grade

With almost 20 children to keep track of and several reasons to collect money, this helps me out tremendously and reduces the likelihood of errors. Also, if the envelope is left on the bus or dropped in the hallway, this information will help get the money to the right place.

Lunch and Breakfast

Breakfast and lunch are **FREE** for all students this year. Breakfast will begin promptly at 8:30 and will end promptly at 8:40. Please be sure your child is on time to school if you are planning on participating in breakfast at school.

Behavior

Students will start the day on "B". Throughout the day your child will have the opportunity to move up for meeting or exceeding proper 2nd grade expectations and down for misbehavior. Your child's behavior grade will be recorded in his/her agenda daily for you to see.
